

**Romans 8:24-39**

**24** *For in hope* we have been saved, but hope that is seen is not hope; for who hopes for what he already sees?

**25** *But if we hope* for what we do not see, with perseverance we wait eagerly for it.

**26** *In the same way* the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words;

**27** *and He who searches* the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

**28** *And we know* that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.

**29** *For those whom* He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren;

**30** *and these whom* He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified.

**31** *What then shall* we say to these things? If God is for us, who is against us?

**32** *He who did not spare* His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?

**33** *Who will bring* a charge against God's elect? God is the one who justifies;

**34** *who is the one* who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us.

**35** *Who will separate* us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

**36** *Just as it is written,* "FOR YOUR SAKE WE ARE BEING PUT TO DEATH ALL DAY LONG; WE WERE CONSIDERED AS SHEEP TO BE SLAUGHTERED."

**37** *But in all these things* we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.

**38** *For I am convinced* that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers,

**39** *nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing,* will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
